





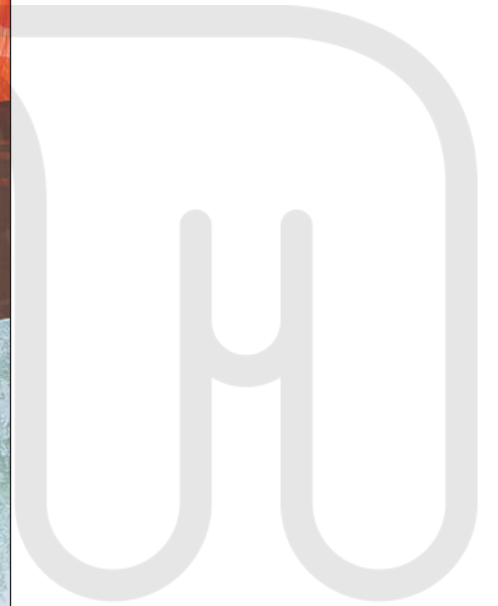

Meet Foncho, a Fairtrade farmer in Colombia, who proudly grows the bananas that end up on supermarket shelves around the world.

Foncho's banana plants grow quickly in the hot sun!



Each banana plant produces one huge bunch. Foncho has used Fairtrade Premium to buy fertilizer & water pipes. That means each bunch has more bananas.

After about 9 months, the bananas are ready for harvesting. Every Tuesday, Foncho and the team climb a ladder to cut down bunches of green bananas.

A worker carries them very carefully to the processing station. The bunches can weigh over 100 pounds!

Processors cut the bunches into 'hands' of six bananas.
